Make Reservations Early - Hotels & Motels That Will Accept Dogs

Hotel policies may change toward dogs, please verify current policies when making reservations.

These hotels, to the best of our knowledge, will welcome you and your dog. It's still a good idea to double-check when making your reservations as sometimes hotel policies change between the publication of the premium list and the show dates. Please remember that you MAY NOT wash your dogs in hotel bathrooms as the dog hair wreaks havoc on the plumbing system. Remember to be a responsible dog owner and clean up after your dogs on hotel grounds and Show Grounds. We recommend plastic sheeting under crates in hotel rooms and please do not leave your dog unattended in the room. Hotel managers do know to contact the Event Committee if rooms or grounds are left in an unacceptable condition. If complaints are received, the offending exhibitor may be subject to an Event Committee Hearing and sanctions from the AKC.

Directions to the Events

I-71 from the North - Go South on I-71 to Exit #32 (Morrow/Lebanon Rt. 123). West on Rt. 123 to Rt. 63. Follow Rt. 63 West until dead-ends into Rt. 4. Take Rt. 4 South to Hamilton, show site on left.

I-75 from the North or South - Exit #24 (Rt. 129). West on Rt. 129 until the freeway ends at Fair Ave. Turn right on Fair Ave. for about ½ mile. Fairgrounds entrance on right.

I-71 from the South - Combines with I-75 South of Cincinnati. Go North into Ohio to Exit #24 (Rt. 129). Then follow I-75 North or South directions.

I-74 from the West - Take the I-275 to I-75. Then follow I-75 North or South directions.

I-74 from the East - Take I-275 North to I-75. Then follow I-75 North or South directions.

Parking Information

Parking fees: \$5.00 per vehicle per day. 3 day pass \$10.00, (multi-day pass with in/out privileges).

Day parking with electrical: \$15.00 per day with in/out privileges.

RV Parking: \$35.00 per night with electrical, water available (no hookups) with in/out privileges.

Limited RV Parking with full hookups (electrical, water, sewer) \$45.00 per night.
