Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule printed in this program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show-giving Club and Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Being an unbench show, you need to be at show only in time for your judging and may leave any time after judging. Numbers before each Breed represent the number of dogs entered in (1) the regular dog classes; (2) regular bitch classes; (3) Specials Only, Best of Breed or Best of Variety Competition; and in (4) Non-Regular classes.

DIRECTIONS TO THE HOTEL

FROM I-84 travel 1.7 miles to exit 49 for I-184/Franklin Rd toward City Center. Travel 0.7 miles and keep left to continue on I-184E, follow signs for I-184. Go another 2.7 miles, take exit 3 for Fairview Ave. Merge onto Fairview Ave for 0.4 miles. Turn left onto N. Garden St., go 450 ft and turn left onto W. Main St for 150 ft. Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto US-20W/US-26 ramp to Garden City/Fairgrounds, travel 0.2 miles to Hotel.

AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

Boise Airport (BOI) is approx 12 minutes from the hotel. Hotel has a shuttle service from airport to hotel.

IMPORTANT HOTEL INFORMATION

- All dogs MUST be crated when left unattended in the Hotel guest rooms.
- **Plastic is required under all crates. Exhibitors are responsible for BRINGING THEIR OWN PLASTIC!**
- There is a limit of 4 dogs per room at any given time.
- The grooming room will have space available for crating dogs but will not be monitored by security.
- Dogs will be able to stay in the grooming room overnight however the grooming room will be locked each night at 11:00 p.m. & reopen at 6:00 a.m.
- All exhibitors & guests are expected to maintain clean conditions & use good housekeeping habits in all areas.
- This includes the show site, guest rooms & hotel grounds. In addition, all exhibitors & guests are expected to abide by all posted restrictions & regulations. Those who do not comply are subject to possible expulsion from the show site and/or hotel premises, as well as subject to a show hearing in accordance with AKC Rules & Regulations Applying to Dog Shows in Dealing with Misconduct.
- Hotel guest rooms will be cleaned daily – NO EXCEPTIONS. The Hotel staff will do a walk-through of each room at check-in & check-out.
- Dogs may NOT be bathed or groomed in the guest rooms.
- Housekeeping must have access to rooms daily and will report anyone who is not in compliance. All grooming must be done in the grooming areas, there will be an outside dog bathing area.
- Dogs are not allowed in the front lobby, hallway past the dining room, courtyard areas, pool areas, or in the landscaping near the building.
- Exercise areas will be clearly marked.
- There will be room provided for unentered dogs.
- There will be Grooming Area Available at the Show.
- PLEASE TURN OFF CELL PHONES and/or PAGERS BEFORE ENTERING RINGS.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."
