EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after their own dog(s).
Pooper scoopers will be placed around the show grounds for your convenience.
If your dog soils in the show ring, the ring steward will hold your dog while you do
the clean up. A pooper scooper will be placed outside each ring.

Responsible dog owners realize clean up after their dogs is their responsibility!

IMPORTANT HOTEL/SITE INFORMATION

- All dogs MUST be crated when left unattended in the Hotel guest rooms.
- Plastic is required under all crates. GSPC of Washington will provide plastic at the welcome desk.
- There is a limit of 4 dogs per room at any given time.
- Dogs will be able to stay in the grooming room overnight however the room will be locked each night at 11:00 p.m. & reopen at 6:00 a.m. Non entered dogs may stay in the grooming/crating room also.
- All exhibitors & guests are expected to maintain clean conditions & use good housekeeping habits in all areas. This includes the show site, guest rooms & hotel grounds. In addition, all exhibitors & guests are expected to abide by all posted restrictions & regulations. Those who do not comply are subject to possible expulsion from the show site and/or hotel premises, as well as subject to a show hearing in accordance with AKC Rules & Regulations Applying to Dog Shows in Dealing with Misconduct.
- Housekeeping must have access to rooms daily and will report anyone who is not in compliance. Dogs may NOT be bathed or groomed in the guest rooms. All grooming must be done in the grooming areas, there will be an outside dog bathing area.
- Dogs are not allowed in the front lobby, hallway past the dining room, courtyard areas, pool areas, or in the landscaping near the building.
