ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- Electrical Hookups are available for a charge of \$30.00 for the one day or \$50.00 for the weekend. This does not apply to the Grooming Building.
- We recommend that all dogs present at this show be immunized for Parvo Virus.
- Crates will be allowed in Exhibitors Building while showing ONLY and at the discretion of the Show Committee.
- NO FLEXI-LEADS allowed on Show Grounds.
- NO PRIVATE EX-PENS ALLOWED IN BUILDINGS.
- SHOW SITE & RESTROOMS are handicapped accessible.
- No Motorized vehicles allowed in the Ring Area.
- Please turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
- \$5.00 per car for Exhibitors & Spectators. This does not apply for those paying for Camping Spots.**
- Grooming Area close to the ring under grandstand.
- Parents will be responsible for unattended children.
- Buildings are UNHEATED so it will be cool in the A.M. depending on weather. PLAN ACCORDINGLY.
- Dog Owners are responsible for individual clean-up on outer Pasture areas of grounds.
- Designated "HANDICAP PARKING ONLY" between grandstand and conformation building.
- Exhibitors/Visitors must display good sportsmanship behavior.
