The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, in accordance with AKC rules and regulations. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. or any official thereof.

GROOMING HOURS – PLEASE NOTE THIS IMPORTANT CHANGE FOR 2019!

Due to Heritage Park scheduling issues, Reserved Grooming in the Kern Pavilion, Non-Reserved Grooming Areas, and Handler Parking WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE for exhibitors to set up until MONDAY, APRIL 29, at 5:00 p.m. The grooming buildings will be open from 6:00 a.m.-10:00 p.m. daily, Tuesday, April 30-Saturday, May 4, with the exception of Thursday. On Thursday evening, the Kern Pavilion will close for grooming during the Top 20/10, 6:00-9:30 p.m., and will reopen after the Top 20/10 and remain open until 10:30 p.m. There will be NO security personnel on duty overnight in the grooming areas.

No Grooming (bathing-trimming-powdering etc.) of any dog will be permitted in hotel guest rooms. Violations will be reported to the Event Committee and are subject to discipline. ALL hotel sites are under the jurisdiction of the Event Committee.

Dog Washing Stations with warm water for bathing will be provided outside on the show grounds.

THERE IS NO SPACE provided for unentered dogs.

OBSERVE FIRE LANES Street parking is not permitted by the Kern Pavilion. Observe the "No Parking" signs and park in designated parking areas only. All fire lanes will be strictly enforced.

EXHIBITORS ALONE ARE RESPONSIBLE for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be subject to Bench Show Hearing and be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

NO SMOKING is allowed under any show/grooming tent where the dog show is conducted. This is by order of the Frankenhuth Fire Department.

Use of Flex Leads is prohibited on the show grounds.

THE CITY OF FRANKENMUTH prides itself in having handicapped accessible Parking, Restrooms and Ramps throughout the City. Our hotel has handicapped accessible rooms. Restrooms at show site are handicapped accessible.

STATE LAWS regarding Handicapped Parking areas will be strictly enforced. Please observe these laws and do not park in these areas unless your vehicle is so designated.

WAIVER OF RIGHTS — ANIMALS IN DISTRESS

The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked car or crate, and all persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club for such removal. The Club regards the health, safety, and life of any dog on the show grounds to be paramount to other property or privacy rights. We will not page anyone. We will act! Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress, or in harm's way (for example, left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress, or harm's way is considered mistreatment and subject to appropriate discipline.

PLEASE HELP KEEP THE GROUNDS & BUILDINGS CLEAN

Show attendees are responsible for cleaning up after the animals in their care. "Poop Stations" with plastic bags and trash cans will be located in the designated dog walking areas and will be patrolled on a regular basis. There will be numerous trash receptacles and cleaning equipment stations in the Grooming Building, and everyone is encouraged to keep his/her area free of accumulated dog hair and other trash. Absolutely no grooming (bathing, trimming, powdering, etc.) will be permitted in any hotel guest room. Everyone's cooperation in taking care of the show site will be greatly appreciated.

DOG HEALTH

The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or any other cause, in accordance with AKC Rules and Regulations. No one shall have claim or recourse against the Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. or any official thereof.

No dog shall be eligible to compete and will be removed immediately from the show grounds if it:

- Show clinical symptoms of distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis, or other communicable disease, or
- Is known to have been in contact with distemper, infectious hepatitis, or other communicable disease, or
- Has been kenneled within 30 days prior to the opening of the show at which there existed distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis, or other communicable diseases.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.
