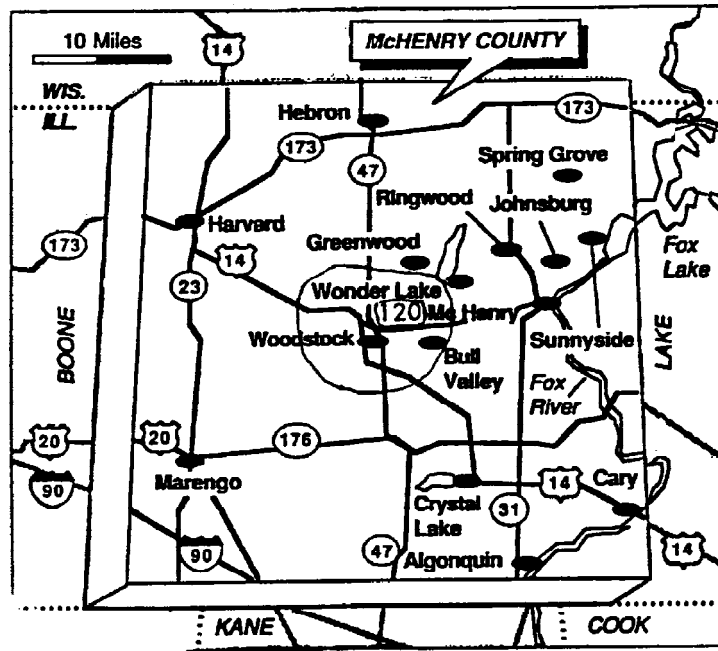


ROUTE TO SHOW

McHENRY COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS is East of Woodstock, IL Route 47 North of Hwy 14 (Approximately one (1) Mile To County Club Road East to Fairgrounds Entrance.)



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1) A PARKING FEE OF \$5.00 PER CAR WILL BE CHARGED.
- 2) No fee for admission.
- 3) OVERNIGHT CAMPING FEE-\$30.00 including limited electric where available for air conditioned units. DAILY FEE \$30.00 charged to units using electricity to run air conditioners and Water Hook-up. Limited availability. These fees are required by the Fairgrounds and will be collected by Mike Costa or Judy Cooper, or Fairgrounds Staff. All checks to be made payable to McHenry County Fairgrounds.
- 4) Food & Beverages will be available throughout the day. Breakfast & Lunch will be available.
- 5) Grooming - There will be facilities for grooming both indoors & under roofs.
- 6) There will be no space provided for unentered dogs.
- 7) No dogs allowed in Building D.
- 8) Show site is handicapped accessible.
- 9) Please turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering ring.
- 10) Only AKC eligible dogs are allowed on the show grounds.
- 11) NO PARKING WITHIN 50' FEET OF RINGS.
- 12) NO RETRACTABLE LEASHES/FLEXI LEASHES.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

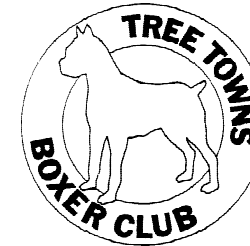
Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show-giving Club and Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Being an unbenched show, you need to be at show only in time for your judging and may leave any time after judging. Numbers before each Breed represent the number of dogs entered in (1) the regular dog classes; (2) regular bitch classes; (3) Specials Only, Best of Breed or Best of Variety Competition; and in (4) Non-Regular classes.

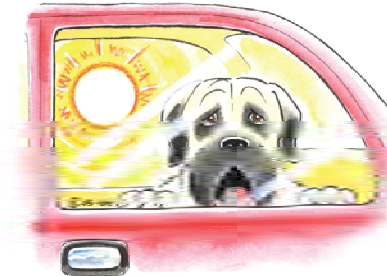
