### NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Only)

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**STUD DOG CLASS** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class & must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Award only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Stud Dog & Get must be entered in a regular class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

\*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class & a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

**BRACE CLASS** - This Class shall be for two dogs, (a Unit), of the same breed irrespective of sex, belonging to one or more common owner. Dogs entered in each Brace Class Unit must each also be entered in another Class. Show Brace Class in "Additional Class" portion of the entry form. If more than once Brace is entered by one or more common owner the dogs comprising EACH Brace Unit must be designated "Brace #1", "Brace #2", etc.

Presented By Dr. Jessica Hekman, DVM, PhD

Dr. Jessica Hekman is a postdoctoral associate at the Broad Institute of MIT and Harvard, where she researches how genetics affect behavior in pet and working dogs. Jessica received her Ph.D. in animal sciences (genetics, genomics, and bioinformatics) in 2017 from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, where she studied canine behavioral genetics. Previously, Jessica graduated from the Tufts Cummings School of Veterinary Medicine in 2012 with a dual DVM/MS degree.

Her Master's work was on the behavior and cortisol responses of healthy dogs to being hospitalized overnight. She also completed a shelter medicine veterinary internship at the University of Florida Maddie's Shelter Medicine Program. Jessica lives in Marlborough, MA with her husband and two dogs: Dashiell, an English shepherd who does agility, parkour, and rally; and Jenny, a shy mixed breed dog who does parkour.

**4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition  
FRIDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2019**

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Classes will be offered for Breeds & Varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class Breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous Class competition will be equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS Competition will be the equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS Number of FSS Registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS Breed Entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- **Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class.** Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. - Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

Higher level awards to a puppy such as Reserve Winners or Best of Opposite Sex, defeats all other puppies from all previous classes for that sex. Best of Winners defeats all other puppies of both sexes. Awards of Merit placements superseded all other puppies. A puppy winning Best of Breed is automatically awarded Best Puppy.

**BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS** - The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; not Champions of Record on the date of closing of entries for the show; individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

**BEST VETERAN** - First Place winners in each regular veteran class will compete for Best Veteran after Best of Breed judging. Awards of Merit placements supersede all other veterans of that sex. A Veteran winning Best of Breed is automatically awarded Best Veteran.

**NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Only)**

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**STUD DOG CLASS** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class & must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Award only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Stud Dog & Get must be entered in a regular class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

\*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class & a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

**BRACE CLASS** - This Class shall be for two dogs, (a Unit), of the same breed irrespective of sex, belonging to one or more common owner. Futurity is an event held in conjunction with the National Specialty. It is similar to a Puppy Sweepstakes except the nomination process is open only to breeders & co-breeders all of which must be members in good standing with the American Bullmastiff Association, Inc. (ABA).

Breeders of Futurity nominated dogs are responsible for informing their owners on the correct entry procedures for the Futurity competition. The Futurity Chair or Show Secretary will not be held responsible for incorrectly entered Futurity dogs & will remain indifferent & impartial to any differences over winnings between breeder and/or co-breeder & the owner.

A Futurity involves a series of nominations prior to the date on which the Futurity is judged. Bitches that have been bred are first placed in nomination at a fee set by the ABA, prior to the whelping. After the puppies are whelped, one or more of the litter may be nominated at 12 weeks & 6 months of age.

2018. The litter must be nominated prior to the whelping of the litter. The nomination process is completed in accordance with the ABA Futurity Standing Rules & must be completed by the breeder(s) of record or lessee of the bitch.

ABA National Specialty dates are subject to change. In the event that a litter is eligible for two national futurity entries, the breeder of the litter must select which entry they would like to nominate the litter for.

The Futurity class is considered a second entry in addition to a regular class for the National Specialty. Under the "additional class" section of the entry form, enter "Futurity" along with the proper age category.

### TRIATHLON RULES

The Triathlon will be comprised of competition in three (3) areas:

- 1) Standard Agility (Regular or Preferred jump heights)
- 2) Obedience and/or Rally Obedience
- 3) Conformation

**Dogs must be entered in regular classes for Obedience, Rally Obedience, and either Regular or Preferred Agility. Preferred, Graduate or Beginner Novice obedience classes will not be included in calculations for the Triathlon even if offered.**

Dogs may compete for all levels they are eligible for and additional points will be awarded for upper level classes.

**Dogs that achieve a qualifying score in obedience, rally and agility will receive 10 bonus points for each "Q".**

Teams participating in the Triathlon may choose to compete in Obedience and/or Rally Obedience. Scores will be adjusted to allow for the significant difference in level of skills and difficulty required between Obedience and Rally Obedience. For teams competing in both Obedience and Rally, the highest score earned will be counted.

The same team of dog and handler must complete all three phases of the competition with no exceptions. The handler must be a registered owner of the dog or a member of the immediate family of the owner of the dog.

### CONFORMATION

Dogs will be judged according to the official AKC standard with the exception that spayed and neutered dogs may compete in Triathlon competition. A judge will be appointed by the National Show Committee with the approval of the ABA Board.

A total of 100 possible points may be awarded by the judge with dogs to be scored and placed according to the points earned. **Each dog will be judged separately by the Triathlon conformation judge according to the official AKC standard.** The scores will be recorded by the judge in the Triathlon conformation scorecard that is provided. Any dog disqualified by the judge will receive no score.

### OBEEDIENCE

**Novice:** Qualifying score divided by 2 (if NQ actual points earned from official judges score sheet and divided by 2)

**Open:** Qualifying score + 15 divided by 2 (if NQ actual points earned from official judges score sheet +15 and divided by 2)

**Utility:** Qualifying score +30 divided by 2 (if NQ actual points earned from official judges score sheet +30 and divided by 2)

For dogs competing in both Open and Utility or Novice and Open, the highest score earned will be used. If the dog has NQ'd in both Open and Utility or Novice and Open the highest score shall be used.

### RALLY

Novice: Score multiplied by .4

Intermediate: Score multiplied by .425

Advanced: Score multiplied by .55

Excellent: Score multiplied by .65

Master: Score multiplied by .85

For dogs competing in Advanced, Excellent and/or Master only the highest score earned will be used.

### AGILITY (Standard or Preferred jump heights)

Novice: Score

Open: Score +10

Excellent/Master: Score +20

(F) Failure = 10 points

(R) Refusals/run outs =5 points

(W) Wrong course = 5 points

(E) Excusal = No score (eliminating in ring, leaving ring, judge determines dog is out of control, course not complete).

Time faults = 1 point per second

There is a significant difference in difficulty between Rally and Obedience competition. Rally does not require the same skills as Obedience (i.e. in Rally handlers may talk/encourage/praise dogs, give multiple commands, retry exercises and complete only a short sit/stay upon command. In Obedience, dogs work without multiple commands, without encouragement/praise during exercises, exercises cannot be retried, dogs complete much longer sits off lead). So while a choice is given to compete in Rally or Obedience for the Triathlon scores must be adjusted to reflect the difficulty for each.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

The list of Table and Ramp breeds can be found on the AKC Website under Conformation Judges – Announcements. Emergencies In emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

*(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).*
