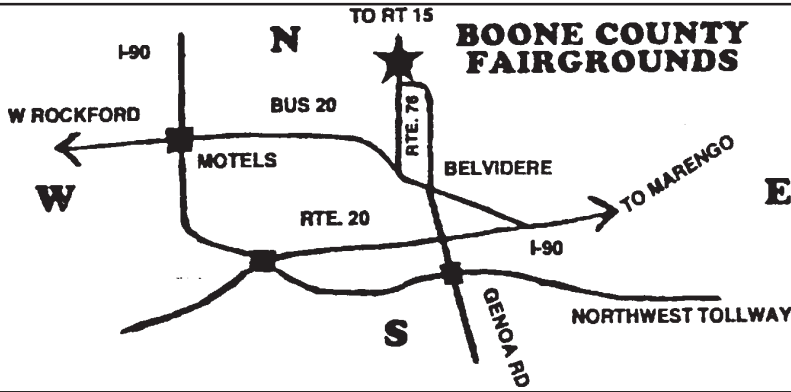

AKC National Owner-Handled Series presented All 4 Days by...**Blackhawk Kennel Club, Inc., Thu., July 13, 2017 & Fri., July 14, 2017****Kishwaukee Kennel Club, Inc., Sat., July 15, 2017 & Sun., July 16, 2017**

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
 - Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
 - Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.
 - If the Best of Breed/Variety winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, it will also be awarded Owner Handled Best of Breed. In this case, the dog will be eligible to compete in group competition for the regular show and group competition for the AKC National Owner Handled Series.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
 - If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, Owner Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded and the Breed/Variety will not be represented in group competition for the AKC National Owner Handled Series.

RULES: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred By Exhibitor in each Breed/Variety from the Bred By Exhibitor class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed/Variety Competition unless the Best Bred By Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred By Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed/Variety. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred By Exhibitor class are eligible for the Best Bred By Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete**.

All Best Bred By Exhibitor in Breed/Variety will compete in their respective Best Bred By Exhibitor Group. All Best Bred By Exhibitors in Group will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show.

THERE WILL BE NO ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEE FOR THIS COMPETITION. DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN THE REGULAR BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION.

PROFESSIONAL HANDLERS ARE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE PROVIDED THEY HAVE BRED AND OWN THE DOG THEY ARE SHOWING.

There will be a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor breed and group judging on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class-For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed/Variety Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.
Brood Bitch Class-Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Lagotti Romagnoli, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels*, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Basset Hounds*, Cirneco dell'Eta, Whippets, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs*, Chinese Shar-Pei*, Chow Chows*, Finish Spitz, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs & Norrbottenspets (misc).

*By Board approved policy Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei & Chow Chows must be judged on the ramp in all conformation competition associated with AKC conformation dog shows or at which AKC conformation titles may be earned.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. This policy extends to Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

The list of Table and Ramp breeds can be found on the AKC Website under Conformation Judges - Announcements. Emergencies in emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).

How to Count Grand Championship Points at AKC Dog Shows

This document has been created for you by the American Kennel Club to help you understand the point schedule and how Grand Championship points are counted. A dog must be (1) A Champion of Record or (2) have been transferred to a higher level of achievement to be eligible for Grand Championship (GC) competition for a title in a discipline (e.g. Obedience, Rally, etc.).

The American Kennel Club requires a dog to obtain a total of 25 points with three major wins (a major win is worth three points or higher) to become a Grand Champion. The major wins are won under three different judges and at four under at least four different judges. Also at least one Champion of Record must be defeated at least once.

Best of Breed - BOB: Best of Opposite Sex - BOS
Select 1 dog - SO: Select Bitch - SB
Remember, point schedules vary by show location. If you are not at the show, find out your point schedule for the event region where your dog will be shown. The Grand Championship point schedule is determined by the same national point schedule that are used for the calculation of championship (CH) points.

Check the printed tapes of the judge's book before you leave the show to make certain your dog was marked correctly. Mistakes happen! Also, verify that your dog's AKC registration number is correct in the catalog. If it is not correct, let the representative know before the show. In both cases, it's easier to make the correction than the day after the show.

How to Figure Points if Your Champion Dog or Bitch Goes Best of Opposite Sex

If the judge elects to award GC points to the BOB winner, we count all dogs of their sex competing.
