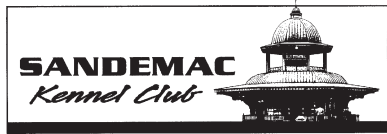

ALL ENTRIES must be submitted with checks drawn on U.S. Institutions or with International Money Orders
in U.S. Funds.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming
table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be
removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the
grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW VETERINARIANS OFFICES

NORTHGATE PET CLINIC: Exit the Main Gate of the Fairgrounds, turn left onto Sangamon Avenue, and go to Interstate 55 South. Follow 55 S to Interstate 72 to Decatur, IL, exit 51 South to Pershing Road, turn left, continue to Martin Luther King Jr. Drive (Ford Dealership on right), turn right, continue one block, Northgate Pet Clinic is on the left. (Approximately 40 miles).

ANIMAL EMERGENCY CLINIC: Exit the Main Gate of the Fairgrounds, turn right onto Sangamon Avenue, and go to Fifth St. Turn right onto Fifth St. to the traffic light at Browning Rd. and turn left. Take Browning Rd. to the first traffic light (Veterans Parkway) and turn left. Take Veterans Parkway 6.8 miles to Wabash Ave. (just past White Oaks Mall), turn left. Take Wabash Ave. 2 miles. The Animal Emergency Clinic is on the left hand side of the road.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site Building will be available to exhibitors after 2:00 PM Thursday. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging of the Mattoon Kennel Club, Inc. show on Sunday. Exhibitors should be advised of the following rules. Any failure to comply with these rules will result in charges brought before the Event Committee.

- **WE ENCOURAGE ALL EXHIBITORS NOT TO LEAVE DOGS IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT. IF LEFT, CONTACT INFORMATION SHOULD BE LEFT WITH NIGHT SECURITY. THE EXPO BUILDING WILL BE LOCKED AT 10:00 PM AND OPENS AT 6:00 AM DAILY.**
- **The Central Illinois Cluster does not encourage saving space. In any case, where too much space has been saved and such space is needed for other exhibitor's grooming, the Cluster Committee or Show Chairs will condense grooming spaces to accommodate all exhibitors.**
- No private exercise pens allowed inside the Show Building at any time. This includes cocker & puppy pens. The Event Committee retains the right to designate what constitutes exercise pens & crates. Outside exercise pens only in designated area.
- **GROOMING AND CRATING OF DOGS ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS. THOSE AREAS WILL BE MARKED & STRICTLY ENFORCED. PLEASE STACK CRATES. PLEASE NOTE: IF USED, ALL GROOMING AREAS ON THE SECOND FLOOR WILL BE PROTECTED BY VISQUEEN.**
- **Coffee Pots, Crockpots, Microwaves, Ovens, etc.** will not be allowed in the Show Building. If a circuit is blown due to use of coffee pots, crockpots, microwaves, ovens, etc., a fee of **\$50.00** will be charged to the individual to restore the power.
- Rugs, carpets or matting will not be allowed.
- No working of dogs in the rings during non-show hours.
- All dogs must be on a lead at all times.
- The Central Illinois Cluster insists all persons keep the show building, grounds, parking lots & motel rooms clean & free from damage. Those exhibitors ignoring this request will be brought before the Event Committee.
- **NOTE: Buildings are unheated.**
- **ALL DAILY & OVERNIGHT VEHICLE PARKING** is controlled by the Illinois State Fairgrounds Security & the Event Committee has no jurisdiction over camping spaces.
- **THE WELFARE OF EXHIBITORS' CHILDREN IS ASSUMED TO BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITORS. IT IS DISTINCTLY UNDERSTOOD THAT EXHIBITORS WILL EXERCISE CONTROL & RESTRAINT OVER THEIR CHILDREN WHILE ON THE SHOW PREMISES.**
- **Security on grounds;** however, no responsibility for dogs or other properties will be accepted by the Central Illinois Cluster, the show-giving clubs, the Illinois State Fairgrounds or the Illinois Department of Agriculture.
- **NO SOFT SIDED CRATES, NO EX-PENS WITH WIRE FLOORS TO BE USED AS CRATES.**
- **THOSE INDIVIDUALS UTILIZING BABY BUGGIES, STROLLERS, OR CARRIAGES (MOTORIZED SCOOTERS FOR HANDICAP USE EXCEPTED) SHOULD TAKE NOTICE OF THE POSTED RECOMMENDATIONS DEALING WITH THE USE OF THESE VEHICLES THROUGHOUT THE DOG SHOW AND AROUND THE DOGS IN THE EXPO BUILDING.**
- **NO CELL PHONES ALLOWED IN THE SHOW RINGS.**
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Some judges may be using appliances for the handicapped (i.e., canes, walkers, wheelchairs).
- **Ringside crates may be used in designated areas no more than 15 minutes before or after judging.**
- **No saving parking space** around show buildings.
- South overhead door will be closed at 10:00 PM on Thursday & not opened until after Best In Show Sunday.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

RV Parking at Illinois State Fairgrounds

State Fairground personnel are the final authority on RV Parking

ALL OVERNIGHT PARKING IN DESIGNATED AREA ONLY - \$30.00 PER NIGHT. THE OVERNIGHT PARKING FEE IS ESTABLISHED BY THE ILLINOIS STATE FAIRGROUNDS RENTAL OFFICE. ALL OVERNIGHT FEES COLLECTED BY SECURITY ARE REMITTED TO THE ILLINOIS STATE FAIRGROUNDS. A \$25.00 fee will be assessed for any return checks.

RV parking for the Central Illinois Classic will be in the **Carnival Midway** area along the south curve of the race track.

ELECTRICAL HOOKUPS are limited to **30 amps**. These are GFI (ground fault interrupter) circuits. If your unit will not operate on GFI, please notify us. If you require **50 amps**, please utilize our permanent campground located in the southwest corner of the fairgrounds just inside Gate 11. **ELECTRICAL HOOKUPS** are limited to one connection per camping unit.

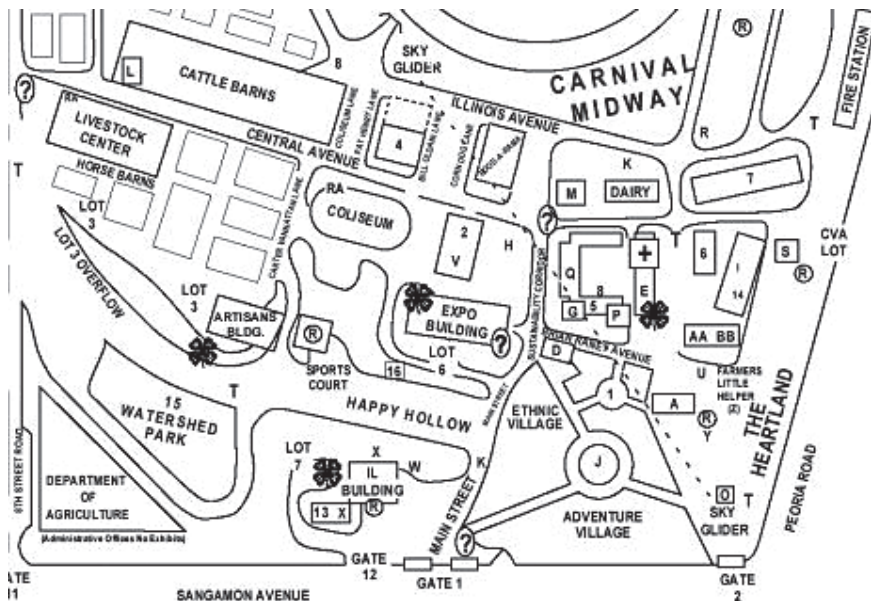
The **ELECTRICAL DEPARTMENT** is staffed Monday through Friday from 6:30 A.M. until 4:30 P.M. Their phone number is (217) 782-0791. At all other times, contact Security at (217) 782-2622 (office) or (217) 725-0120 (cell).

If an **AFTER HOURS** call-out is required for the electrical shop, and the cause is due to system failure, there will be no charge. If the call is necessitated by negligence or failure to follow campground requirements, **the responsible individual will be billed at prevailing labor rates.**

You must display your camping permit in the windshield or other highly visible location of your camper while you are attending your event. Otherwise, your camper may be tagged as not permitted and subject to tow at owner's expense.

RV parking spaces are on a first come, first served basis. If you need more information from the Illinois State Fairgrounds Staff, they can be reached at **(217) 782-0775**.

THERE WILL BE NO ELECTRICAL HOOKUPS ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF RV PARKING AREA. THERE IS NO 50 AMP SERVICE IN THE RV PARKING AREA. ONLY ONE 30 AMP DROP PER VEHICLE IS PERMITTED. 50 AMP SERVICE IS AVAILABLE IN CAMPING AREA ON SOUTHWEST CORNER OF FAIRGROUNDS AT GATE 11.

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

All dogs four (4) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs must be at least 4 months of age on the date of the event.

The following breed classes will be offered at all FSS Open Shows: (All Classes Divide by sex)

4-6 Month Puppy Class	Bred-By-Exhibitor Class
6-9 Month Puppy Class	Open Class
9-12 Month Puppy Class	

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

- Dogs less than 4 months of age are ineligible to be on the grounds of licensed or member shows during AKC events.
- Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol (including rabies vaccination) in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open Shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.
- Any person acting in the capacity of Show Secretary at an FSS Open Show, or any member of his immediate household or immediate family (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows), shall not exhibit, act as agent or handler at the event, and dogs owned wholly or in part by the show secretary or by any member of their immediate household or immediate family shall be ineligible to be entered at that show.
- No judge or any person residing in the same household with a judge shall exhibit or act as agent or handler at an FSS Open Show at which they are officiating as judge and dogs owned wholly or in part by such judge or any member of their household shall be ineligible to be entered at the show. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed. Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Classes will be offered for Breeds & Varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class Breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous Class competition will be equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS Competition will be the equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS Number of FSS Registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS Breed Entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed. Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.
