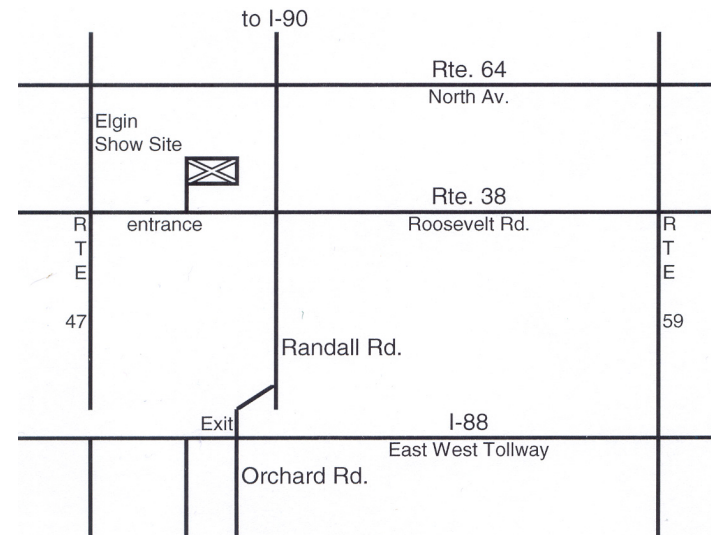

RV Parking Reservation Form

Reservations Must be Made by Entry Closing

Our show site has 39 Hook-ups for RV's with both Water and Electric. Spaces will be assigned. Reservations must be received by closing of entries August 8, 2018. Any reservations received after the spaces have been sold out will be returned. There is a Dump Station on the east side of the RV Parking Area. **Payment in full must be received by the closing Date.** The show site will be made available to RV's beginning at **12:00 P.M. on Friday, August 24, 2018.** The cost per night will be \$45.00 for reserved parking. You will be escorted to your parking space. Do NOT proceed to a RV Parking Space without being escorted. No Reservations will be refunded after show entries closing date. The rates for dry or 20 Amp parking will be \$30.00 per night.

GATES WILL BE LOCKED AT MIDNIGHT EACH EVENING & OPENED AT 6 A.M. The size of each Stall is 16' by 40'. Your vehicle and ex-pens must fit within the parking space provided. If you have a car that is being towed, it must fit inside your space or must be parked in the parking area on the North side of the Building opposite of the RV Parking area. **THERE IS TO BE NO RV PARKING ON THE BLACKTOP ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SHOW BUILDING OR IN THE RV PARKING AREA OUTSIDE OF A DESIGNATED SPACE.**

NO PARKING OR RV'S AFTER 10PM!! You may park in the staging area after that time on the west side of the show site in the gaqvel parking lot. Gate will be re-opened at 6AM the following morning.

Any RV Parking Spaces remaining the Friday prior to the show, will be sold at on a "first come first served" basis until all spaces are filled at the rate of \$50.00 per night.

All sawdust, shavings, or other ex-pen bedding MUST be cleaned up and removed by the individual responsible for that space or a \$40.00 cleanup fine will be charged.

BRED-BY EXHIBITOR CLASS: This Class shall be for dogs that are: Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

VETERAN CLASSES (FOR DOGS & BITCHES)

Veteran Dogs, 6 yrs. & Older Veteran Bitches, 6 yrs. & Older

*Chapter 11, Section 8 "Rules Applying to Dog Shows"

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

BEST PUPPY

BEST OF BREED CLASS: "Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championship are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show."

SPECIAL ATTRACTION.....(Both Days)

BEST PUPPY: During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos. and under 9 mos. and the 9 mos. and under 12 mos. Classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete.**

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Event Secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies.

The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).
