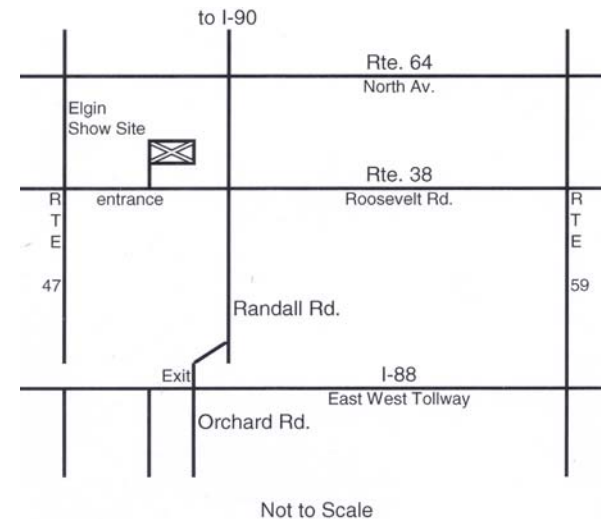

### Reservations Must be Made by Entry Closing

Our show site has 39 Hook-ups for RV's with both Water and Electric. Spaces will be assigned. Reservations must be received by closing of entries August 7, 2019. Any reservations received after the spaces have been sold out will be returned. There is a Dump Station on the east side of the RV Parking Area. **Payment in full must be received by the closing Date.** The show site will be made available to RV's beginning at **12:00 P.M. on Friday, August 23, 2019.** The cost per night will be \$45.00 for reserved parking. You will be escorted to your parking space. Do NOT proceed to a RV Parking Space without being escorted. No Reservations will be refunded after show entries closing date. The rates for dry or 20 Amp parking will be \$30.00 per night.

**GATES WILL BE LOCKED AT MIDNIGHT EACH EVENING & OPENED AT 6 A.M.** The size of each Stall is 16' by 40'. Your vehicle and ex-pens must fit within the parking space provided. If you have a car that is being towed, it must fit inside your space or must be parked in the parking area on the North side of the Building opposite of the RV Parking area. **THERE IS TO BE NO RV PARKING ON THE BLACKTOP ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SHOW BUILDING OR IN THE RV PARKING AREA OUTSIDE OF A DESIGNATED SPACE.**

**BRED-BY EXHIBITOR CLASS:** This Class shall be for dogs that are: Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

#### BEST PUPPY COMPETITION

**BEST OF BREED CLASS:** "Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championship are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show."

#### SPECIAL ATTRACTION.....(Both Days)

**BEST PUPPY:** During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos. and under 9 mos. and the 9 mos. and under 12 mos. Classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete.**
