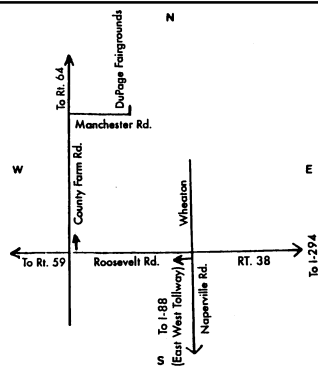

- **PARKING & ELECTRICAL HOOKUP INFORMATION**
 This year, the fairground has updated the power in the paved parking area. The area now has 50, 30 and 20 amp service in several locations. With these new improvements, the fairground has also raised the price that Wheaton KC pays for these hookups. Unfortunately, the Wheaton KC can no longer absorb these costs. - The Chicagoland Dalmatian Club is not responsible for the loss or damage to or death of any dog exhibited, exhibitor, spectator, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- **Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.**
- Dogs may NOT be left in the building overnight.
- **NO SPACE PROVIDED FOR UNENTERED DOGS** All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen. No dogs under six (6) months of age will be allowed within 100 feet of the show rings.
- The use of Flexi-Leads is restricted to the exercise area only. Please do not use them inside the facility.
- As a courtesy to all our exhibitors, please limit all cell phone use to outside the facility, and if it is necessary to carry your cell phone, please set it to vibrate.
- It is every exhibitor's responsibility to pick up after their dogs. Anyone caught not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave and will forfeit their entry.

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
 - Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show.
 - Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
 - Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner Handled Series competition.
 - Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.
 - If the Best of Breed winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, it will also be awarded Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed winner is not eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
 - If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, Owner Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded.

Note: *Chapter 11, Section 8 "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provide that a neutered dog or spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran. Winners of the above classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed Competition at Independent Specialties only.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

AWARD OF MERIT

The judge at his discretion may present an Award of Merit to up to ten percent of the total Best of Breed entry.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class-For Stud Dogs with two and not more than four of their Get. Owners of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owners of the Get. Get must be entered in another class in this show. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification under the AKC Dog Show Rules.

Brood Bitch Class-Same as the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: Chapter 11 Section 8 of The AKC Rules Applying to Dog Show provides that castrated males are allowed to be entered as the Stud Dog and spayed females are allowed to be entered as the Brood Bitch.

Brace Class-Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.
