**• NOTE •**

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.  
 Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.  
 Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

**EXPO RULES AND RV GUIDELINES**

**THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to a show committee hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club.

- Day RV Parking **ONLY** in Gate #1. **No overnight parking will be allowed.** Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV parking area through Gate #3 and will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Noncompliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.
- Entrance to RV Camping is Gate #3.
- Access to Gate #3 – Upon arrival to Gate #3, participants will need to provide a copy of their registration confirmation. Once registration has been verified, a parking pass will be provided to be displayed in the window of the RV. Access to Gate #3 is limited to:
  - o Recreational vehicles with proper parking pass displayed in the window.
  - o Handler/Exhibitor vehicles with proper parking forms displayed in the window. One vehicle per site. Any handler/exhibitors without proper parking confirmations must enter through Gate #1 and use the designated "Handler Drop Off area."
  - o Club members and workers with appropriate pass (Friday – Sunday).
- After 9 p.m., RVs are welcome to enter Gate #3 to be staged in Arena West Parking Lot until the next morning. No electrical hookups available.
- Wednesday (7/26) RV arrivals are welcome from Noon – 9 p.m.
- A noise curfew is in effect from 10 p.m. until sunrise. This applies to all types of loud noises, including, but not limited to, music and stereos. Please be considerate of your neighbors so everyone can have a pleasant time.
- Grills are allowed by individual RV sites only, not on the show grounds. Hot coals should not be dumped into Expo trash containers or dumpsters. Absolutely NO campfires of any kind will be allowed.
- No tent camping will be allowed.
- All dogs must be kept on a 6 ft. or less leash, unless in designated dog show rings.
- All campers are responsible for cleaning up and properly disposing of all trash, recyclable items and dog droppings. Please place items in proper receptacles found throughout the Expo Grounds. Failure to follow this rule may result in additional charges or not being allowed to camp on-site for future shows.

This honor is reserved for those quality Irish Setters the Judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

**SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS.....**

**BEST PUPPY**-During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos. and under 9 mos. and the 9 mos. and under 12 mos. Classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete**.

**BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR**-During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in each Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred By Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete**.

**BEST VETERAN**-During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran in Breed from the Non-Regular Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch Classes. This will be done after Best of Breed & Award of Merit judging. Example: A Veteran Class winner is awarded Best of Breed then Best Veteran award is automatic. Only dogs **not defeated** in regular Veteran classes are eligible to compete for Best Veteran.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**Stud Dog Class**-For Stud Dogs and two, (at least two, no more than four for Irish Setters,) of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed/Variety Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

**Brood Bitch Class**-Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

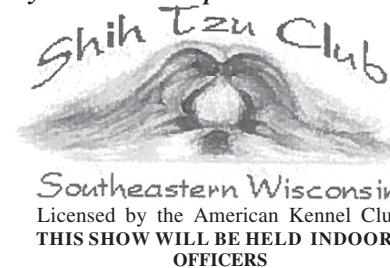

Basset Hounds\* & Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers .

\*By Board approved policy Basset Hounds must be judged on the ramp in all conformation competition associated with AKC conformation dog shows or at which AKC conformation titles may be earned.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. This policy extends to Junior Showmanship. The list of Table and Ramp breeds can be found on the AKC Website under Conformation Judges – Announcements. Emergencies In emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency

is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to

include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).
