EXPO RULES AND RV GUIDELINES

THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to a show committee hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club.

- **The only vehicles allowed within the show area (within 50' of all rings), are First Aid, Security, Expo Staff, and Waukesha Kennel Club dog show staff. All private golf carts, utility vehicles, and ATV's must be used around the outer perimeter of the event.**
- Day RV Parking ONLY in Gate #1. No overnight parking will be allowed. Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV parking area through Gate #3 and will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Noncompliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.
- Entrance to RV Camping is Gate #3.
- Access to Gate #3 – Upon arrival to Gate #3, participants will need to provide a copy of their registration confirmation. Once registration has been verified, a parking pass will be provided to be displayed in the window of the RV. Access to Gate #3 is limited to:
 - o Recreational vehicles with proper parking pass displayed in the window.
 - o Handler/Exhibitor vehicles with proper parking forms displayed in the window. One vehicle per site.
- Any handler/exhibitors without proper parking confirmations must enter through Gate #1 and use the designated "Handler Drop Off area."
- o Club members and workers with appropriate pass (Friday – Sunday).
- After 9 p.m., RVs are welcome to enter Gate #3 to be staged in Arena West Parking Lot until the next morning. No electrical hookups available.
- Wednesday (7/24) arrivals are welcome from Noon – 9 p.m.
- A noise curfew is in effect from 10 p.m. until sunrise. This applies to all types of loud noises, including, but not limited to, music and stereos. Please be considerate of your neighbors so everyone can have a pleasant time.
- Grills are allowed by individual RV sites only, not on the show grounds. Hot coals should not be dumped into Expo trash containers or dumpsters. Absolutely NO campfires of any kind will be allowed.
- No tent camping will be allowed.
- All dogs must be kept on a 6 ft. or less leash, unless in designated dog show rings.
- All campers are responsible for cleaning up and properly disposing of all trash, recyclable items and dog droppings. Please place items in proper receptacles found throughout the Expo Grounds. Failure to follow this rule may result in additional charges or not being allowed to camp on-site for future shows.
- Cancellations of RV Camping and Handler Parking: A full refund will be given if cancelled on or before July 10, 2019. If cancelled July 10, 2019 or later, the reservation fee will be forfeited.

To reserve your RV Overnight Camping site, please logon to:

www.waukeshacounty.gov/expo All reservations are on a first-come-first-serve basis. Booking online provides the best chance of reserving your preferred site.

Make your reservation by using the on-line site starting at 12 a.m., March 1, 2019. Feel free to log on to the site prior to March 1 to view site map and to create your account, which is required to make a reservation.

On March 1, book a site per your preferred amenities i.e. electrical amps, type of parking surface, distance from show rings, and electrical cord length. Credit card payment is required to complete your booking.

2019 Overnight Camping rates:

- o 50 amp site \$50/night
- o 30 amp site \$45/night
- o 20 amp site \$40/night
- o Non Electric \$37/night

All reservations require a Friday and Saturday night stay. Wednesday arrivals are welcome from Noon – 9 p.m.

Cancellations: A full refund will be given if cancelled on or before July 10. If cancelled July 11 or later, all fees will be forfeited.

Here are some quick steps to making your on-line reservation:

- Click on the "WKC Dog Show Campground Reservations" button. Here you will jump to the reservation system.
- Create your account – Click on Create Account in the upper right corner of the reservation screen.

• NOTE •

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

(*Where Offered*)

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace & Team classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class-For Stud Dogs and two, (*at least two, no more than four for Irish Setters,*) of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed/Variety Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

Brood Bitch Class-Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class-For two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owner. Each dog will compete in the Brace Class must be noted on the entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated - "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

CUT DOWN CLASS (*Shih Tzu Only*)

A competition for Shih Tzu that are 6 months or older on the day of the Show and shown with trimmed coat. Ears and tail may be left long. The class will be open to AKC registered Shih Tzu that are not AKC Champions of Record. Neutered dogs & spayed bitches are eligible to participate. This competition will be held following Sweepstakes and prior to the judging of the regular classes. The entry form must be marked "Cut Down Competition" and either Dog or Bitch, in the space for "Additional Classes" must be submitted with the entry fee. There will be a class for Dogs and a class for Bitches with the winners competing for Best Cut Down Shih Tzu.

PARADE OF CHAMPIONS & TITLEHOLDERS (*Shih Tzu Only*)

Open to all AKC Champions and Titleholders. The entry form must be marked "Parade" and either Dog or Bitch, in the space for "Additional Classes" and must be submitted with the entry fee. It will take place after Best of Breed. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
