NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE EVENT, ONLY THE FIRST EVENT WILL BE PROCESSED.

ENTRY FEE is \$28.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event except for Puppy Classes which are \$20.00 for each event. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$22.00 for each event. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP is \$28.00 for each event if entered for 'Junior Showmanship Only' or \$8.00 if an Additional Entry for each event. Four-To-Six Month Beginner Puppy is \$20.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$2.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry in Four-To-Six Month Beginner Puppy. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

ENTRIES CLOSE at Superintendent's Office, WEDNESDAY NOON (EDT), AUGUST 9, 2017, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED with checks drawn on U.S. Institutions or with International Money Orders in U. S. Funds.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

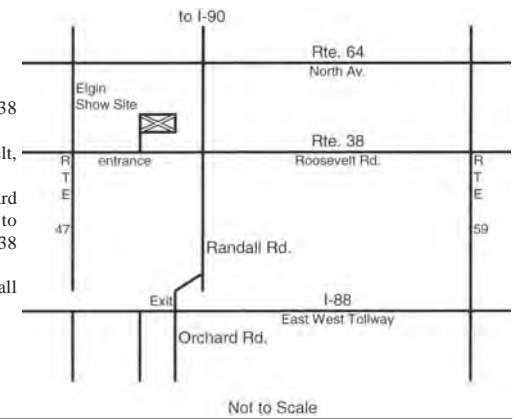
Enter from Rte 38, Roosevelt Rd.

- We are very proud of our show site and are asking your help so it will continue to be available to us.
- No Exercise pens in Building.
- No Exercise pens on porches.
- Exit doors cannot be blocked even though we are not using them for entrance and exit.
- Grooming is allowed on the porches and electric is available.
- No sawdust can be used in private exercise pens.
- Any saved space that is not fully occupied by Crates by 8:00 AM Saturday, August 26, 2017, WILL BE TAKEN DOWN TO MAKE ROOM FOR EXHIBITORS. No Tape, Rope or Cones. Crates Only.
- No Dogs allowed in restrooms.
- No washing of dogs food bowls in the restrooms.
- No unentered dogs allowed on show grounds.
- No Flexie Leads allowed on show grounds.
- Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their grooming area clean.
- Golf carts, scooters and any motorized vehicles (excluding Wheelchairs) are not allowed in the building.
- No Dog/Grooming strollers or any other strollers allowed in the exhibition building.
- Please turn off cell phones and pagers before entering the ring.
- If your dog lifts his leg in a doorway please notify the clean-up people so it can be wiped up.
- Exhibitors are to follow the diagram as marked on the Grooming Area Floor. The Elgin Kennel Club reserves the right to move any exhibitor's crates and equipment who do not follow the diagram for the grooming area to make room for fellow exhibitors.

Reservations Must be Made by Entry Closing

Our show site has 39 Hook-ups for RV's with both Water and Electric. Spaces will be assigned. Reservations must be received by closing of entries August 9, 2017. Any reservations received after the spaces have been sold out will be returned. There is a Dump Station on the east side of the RV Parking Area. The show site will be made available to RV's beginning at **12:00 P.M. on Friday, August 25, 2017**. The cost per night will be \$45.00 for reserved parking. You will be escorted to your parking space. Do NOT proceed to a RV Parking Space without being escorted. No Reservations will be refunded after show entries closing date. The rates for dry or 20 Amp parking will be \$30.00 per night.

The size of each Stall is 16' by 40'. Your vehicle and ex-pens must fit within the parking space provided. If you have a car that is being towed, it must fit inside your space or must be parked in the parking area on the North side of the Building opposite of the RV Parking area. **THERE IS TO BE NO RV PARKING ON THE BLACKTOP ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SHOW BUILDING OR IN THE RV PARKING AREA OUTSIDE OF A DESIGNATED SPACE.**

NO PARKING OR RV'S AFTER 10PM!! You may park in the staging area after that time on the west side of the show site in the gravel parking lot. Gate will be re-opened at 6AM the following morning.

Any RV Parking Spaces remaining the Friday prior to the show, will be sold at on a "first come first served" basis until all spaces are filled at the rate of \$50.00 per night.

All sawdust, shavings, or other ex-pen bedding MUST be cleaned up and removed by the individual responsible for that space or a \$40.00 cleanup fine will be charged.

If you wish to be next to someone else, both reservations need to be sent together in the same envelope with the amount of the deposit equaling the amount due per space.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

SATURDAY, AUGUST 26, 2017

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Classes will be offered for Breeds & Varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class Breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous Class competition will be equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS Competition will be the equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS Number of FSS Registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS Breed Entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.* Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series...

SUNDAY, AUGUST 27, 2017

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
 - Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
 - Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.
 - If the Best of Breed/Variety winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, it will also be awarded Owner Handled Best of Breed. In this case, the dog will be eligible to compete in group competition for the regular show and group competition for the AKC National Owner Handled Series.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
 - If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, Owner Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded and the Breed/Variety will not be represented in group competition for the AKC National Owner Handled Series.

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
