JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT

Awards of Merit will be awarded after Best of Breed judging is completed to Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs in the Best of Breed competition that exemplify the breed's characteristics. These awards are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed. The dogs selected for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not eligible for an Award of Merit. At the judge's discretion, up to six (6) awards of merit for National Specialty and four (4) awards of merit for Independent Specialty will be awarded in the Best of Breed competition, which shall include move-ups, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and first place in Veteran Dog and Bitch Classes.

Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)

All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Best Puppy in Regular Puppy Class

The First Place Winners from the individual Regular Puppy Classes (6-9 mos. and 9-12 mos.) will compete for the award of Best Puppy in the Regular Classes. Best Puppy competition will follow Winners Bitch judging.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes

The First Place Winners from the individual Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes will compete for the award

of Best Bred-By-Exhibitor. Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition will follow Winners Bitch judging on Wednesday.

Best Veteran in the Veteran Classes

The First Place Winners from the Veteran Classes will compete for the award of Best Veteran and Best of Opposite Veteran. Best Veteran competition will follow Best of Breed Judging on Wednesday.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

The Following Classes are offered for Dogs and Bitches

- Veterans 7 years and under 9 years**
- Veterans 9 years and under 11 years**
- Veterans 11 years and over**

Veterans Note: 1st place winners of Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in any other classes at this show. Ribbon prizes will be awarded for first through fourth place in each class. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may be entered.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes

STUD DOG CLASS — For Stud Dog and a minimum of two (2); maximum of four (4) of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Note – Chapter 11, Section 8, of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, provides that neutered dogs may be entered as the Stud Dog.

BROOD BITCH CLASS — Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud

Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS — Full particulars for each dog entered must be given on individual Official AKC Entry forms.

Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

GENERATION CLASS — Three dogs with one exhibit from each generation of a three generation pedigree

regardless of sex, exhibited from oldest to youngest. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible. Ownership does not need to be identical. Dog #1 = Father or Mother, Dog 2 = Son or Daughter, Dog #3 = Grandson or Granddaughter of Dog #1 and Son or Daughter of Dog #2. Dogs entered in the Generations Class do not need to be entered in a regular class.

BREEDER'S CLASS - The breeder of record enters a team with a minimum of three and a maximum of five dogs, without distinction as to gender. The entrant must be the breeder of record for all exhibits. It is not required that the breeder of record be the current owner. All dogs entered must be a minimum of 6 months of age - spayed and neutered dogs are eligible. The team that is exhibited in the Breeder's Class must represent more than one litter and cannot all have identical parentage. Each team will be judged as a unit, standing and moving to determine their overall quality, consistency and similarity, breed type and conformation to the breed standard. Awards will be presented to Best Breeder's Team and Reserve Best Breeder's Team.

When making entries in the Multiple Dog Entry Classes....

PLEASE indicate on the entry forms as to which dog(s) are to make up that entry in each Brace, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch or Generations Classes. If there is to be more than 1 Brace, please indicate as "Brace 1", "Brace 2", etc.

Novice Junior Class - for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class - for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class - for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class - for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open Class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919)233-9767. Bitches in season are not eligible.

Obedience Trial Classification

No Refund for Bitches Who Come In season

REGULAR CLASSES:

Beginner Novice A, Beginner Novice B, Novice A Class, Novice B Class, Open A Class, Open B Class, Utility A Class, Utility B Class

NON-REGULAR CLASSES: Veterans, Team

Veterans Class. The Veterans Class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 7 years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs may be entered in another class or classes.

Team Obedience Class. The Team Class will be for teams of any four dogs that are eligible under these regulations. Five dogs may be entered, one to be considered an alternate for which no entry fee will be required.

However, the same four dogs will perform all exercises. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person, need not be entered in another class at the same trial, and need not have obedience titles. A separate official entry form will be completed in full for each dog entered.

Rally Trial Classification

No Refund For Bitches Who Come In Season

REGULAR CLASSES:

Rally Novice A, Rally Novice B, Rally Advanced A, Rally Advanced B, Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B

NON-REGULAR CLASSES: Team

Puppy Sweepstakes Requirements and Classification

Sweepstakes are open to Greater Swiss Mountain dogs and bitches that are at least 6 months old, but not more than 18 months old on the day of the show. Entry shown in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class".

Professional Handlers will not be allowed to exhibit any dog they do not own or co-own.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

Puppy, 6 Mos & Under 9 Mos; Puppy, 9 Mos & Under 12 Mos; Puppy, 12 Mos & Under 15 Mos; Puppy, 15 Mos & Under 18 Mos

Division of Entry Money as Prizes

Thirty percent (30%) of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 70% will be divided as follows:

- Best in Sweepstakes 15% of Sweepstakes entries
- Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes 10% of Sweepstakes entries
- First Place 30% of Sweepstakes entries
- Second Place 20% of Sweepstakes entries
- Third Place 15% of Sweepstakes entries
- Fourth Place 10% of Sweepstakes entries

Veteran Sweepstakes Requirements & Classification

Veteran Sweepstakes are open to Greater Swiss Mountain dogs and bitches that are 7 years of age and older on the day of the show. Dogs do not have to be entered in a regular class. Veteran Sweepstakes Class and age division must be indicated on the entry form. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes only or as an additional class.

Professional Handlers will not be allowed to exhibit any dog they do not own or co-own.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

7 years and under 9 years, 9 year and under 11 years, 11 years and over

Division of Entry Money as Prizes

Thirty percent (30%) of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 70% will be divided as follows:

- Best in Sweepstakes 15% of Sweepstakes entries
- Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes 10% of Sweepstakes entries
- First Place 30% of Sweepstakes entries
- Second Place 20% of Sweepstakes entries
- Third Place 15% of Sweepstakes entries
- Fourth Place 10% of Sweepstakes entries

Futurity/Maturity

Professional Handlers will not be allowed to exhibit any dog they do not own or co- own.

Entry for Futurity Stake Judging

- A. Puppies are eligible only for the Futurity Stake which occurs in conjunction with the first GSMDCA National Specialty Show held on or after the date that they reach six (6) months of age and are not eligible for Subsequent Futurity Stake judging. Champions of record are eligible to compete.
- B. Futurity entrants must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the GSMDCA National Specialty Show. Fee for this class must be paid.
- C. Futurity Stake entry must be indicated as an additional entry on the official AKC entry form.

Division of Classes

Futurity Stake shall be divided into four age classifications:

- 6 months and under 9 months, Puppy
- 9 months and under 12 months, Puppy
- 12 months and under 15 months, Junior
- Over 15 months, Junior

Division of Total Futurity Stake Monies

Total Futurity Stake monies shall first be divided as follows:

- 25% to Futurity Stake Operating Expense Fund.
- 75% to be divided as specified between the Futurity Stake winners.

Entry for Maturity Stake Judging

- A. Puppies are eligible only for the Maturity Stake which occurs in conjunction with the second GSMDCA National Specialty Show held on or after the date that they reach six (6) months of age and are not eligible for Subsequent Maturity Stake judging. Champions of record are eligible to compete.
- B. Maturity entrants must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the GSMDCA National Specialty Show. Fee for this class must be paid.
- C. Maturity Stake entry must be indicated as an additional entry on the official AKC entry form.

Division of Classes

Maturity Stake shall be divided into two age classifications:

- Under 24 months, Junior
- Over 24 months, Senior

Division of Total Maturity Stake Monies

Total Maturity Stake monies shall first be divided as follows:

- 25% to Maturity Stake Operating Expense Fund.
- 75% to be divided as specified between the Maturity Stake winners.

An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).
