Stay straight to go onto Airport Conn/SR3032. Then 2.45 miles. Take PA-283 W. Then 1.29 miles. Merge onto I-283 S toward I-76/Pennsylvania Tpke (Portions toll). Then 0.49 miles. Turn Right onto Kenneth Road. Then 0.21 miles. Turn Left onto Loucks Road. Then 0.68 miles. Wyndham Garden York, 2000 LOUCKS ROAD is on the Left.

PEE WEE Special Attraction, FRIDAY MAY 10, 2019

Judge: Betsy Yates

- For kids from 5-9 years of age (with a parent or guardian).
- Dog must be at least six (6) months of age to enter.
- All dogs must have proper leash and collar.

The Special Attraction to follow regular class judging when ring becomes available. *An announcement will be made regarding the start time.* Entries are in person up to the start of Pee Wee Class judging on Friday May 10, 2019. There is **NO entry fee**. There is no limit on number of teams. **All participants will receive a ribbon and prize.**

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship Class for children who are at least age 5 and under age 9 years on the date of the show. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience or the child and adult. Each child is accompanied into the ring by a responsible adult who stays with the child at all times; only one Pee Wee Handler and one adult will be in the ring at any one time. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside the ring as well as ensure control inside the ring. A primary goal is safety and a positive experience for the children, so at the judge's discretion, the adult may be required to attach a second leash to the dog in the ring. The dog handled by the Pee Wee Handler must be at least six (6) months of age, must be an AKC registered **German Shorthaired Pointer** (including dogs with a PAL/ILP listing). Bitches in season are not allowed to participate (eligible dogs may be substituted). Dogs must have a proper leash and collar. GSPCA will have a show lead and collar available at ring side if needed. An AKC licensed Junior Showmanship judge will be officiating at this event. Before a Pee Wee participant will be allowed to enter the ring, his or her parent or legal guardian must sign a Release of Liability Form. One will be provided at the show.

Use a standard AKC entry for, and mark Pee Wee in the class box. Entry forms will be provided the day of the show. FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

offered by

GERMAN SHORTHAIRED POINTER CLUB OF AMERICA

WEDNESDAY, MAY 8, 2019

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Classes will be offered for Breed as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23.

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

ELIGIBILITY: Puppies whelped between October 1, 2017 and September 31, 2018 will be eligible for the 2019 Futurity. All breeders and co-breeders of litters nominated for the Show Futurity must be members of the GSPCA at the time of Nomination. (*Pending does not constitute membership*). All owners and co-owners of individual dogs or bitches that compete in the Show Futurity must be members of the GSPCA BEFORE FEB 28th. Second Forfeits will NOT be accepted without a current GSPCA membership number. **If the ownership changes prior to the Futurity, the dog will remain eligible provided all new owners/co-owners are members or applies for membership to the GSPCA. The Futurity Chairman must be notified within 10 days of any changes of ownership.**

NOMINATION: Bitches must be nominated within 56 days (8 weeks) of whelping, and a fee of \$25.00 must accompany the nomination. Any nominations postmarked or finalized online later than 56 days from whelping will be considered late. Litters may be nominated after the 56th day but not later than 112 days (16 weeks), with an additional \$50.00 penalty payment (\$75.00 total). Litters may be nominated after 112 days (16 weeks), with an additional \$200.00 penalty payment (\$225.00 total). No nomination will be accepted if postmarked or finalized online later than 143 days (20 weeks) after whelping.

SENIOR CLASS: For dogs whelped on or after October 1 through January 31. Dogs and bitches will be judged separately.

INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For dogs whelped on or after February 1 through May 31. Dogs and bitches will be judged separately.

JUNIOR CLASS: For dogs whelped on or after June 1 through September 30. Dogs and bitches will be judged separately.

PAYMENT OF FORFEITS: **Three forfeits must be paid as follows:** First Forfeit of \$20.00 must be postmarked or finalized online by December 31; Second Forfeit of \$20.00 must be postmarked or finalized online by February 28 (29); Third Forfeit of \$20.00 (to count as entry fee) must be received at the Superintendent's office by the closing date of the National Specialty Show entries.

The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster. *(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse.
