AWARD OF MERIT

At the conclusion of the Best of Breed Judging, the judge may at her discretion, award up to 10% of the entries eligible for Best of Breed or a minimum of two awards, an Award of Merit. The Judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit, if she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition, worthy of this award. All dogs competing in the Best of Breed competition are eligible for this award, with the exception of the BOB. Each AOM winner will receive a Rosette offered by the German Shorthaired Pointer Club of Washington.

NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Note: As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

Stud Dog Class-For Stud Dogs and no more than two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular or Non Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class.

Brood Bitch Class-Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. Stud Dogs & Brood Bitches may be Spayed or Neutered.

Lagotti Romagnoli, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels*, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Basset Hounds*, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Whippets, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs*, Chinese Shar-Pei*, Chow Chows*, Finish Spitz, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs & Norrbottenspets (misc).

*By Board approved policy Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei & Chow Chows must be judged on the ramp in all conformation competition associated with AKC conformation dog shows or at which AKC conformation titles may be earned.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Event Secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. This policy extends to Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. The list of Table and Ramp breeds can be found on the AKC Website under Conformation Judges - Announcements. Emergencies In emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)
