ENTRY FEE is \$30.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event, except in Puppy Classes & Bred-by-Exhibitor Classes which are \$25.00 each for each event. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$25.00. Veterans Class is \$25.00 each. Stud Dog (Get **MUST BE** entered in a Regular Class) & Brood Bitch (Produce **MUST BE** entered in a Regular Class) is \$20.00 each for each event. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

• NOTE •

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

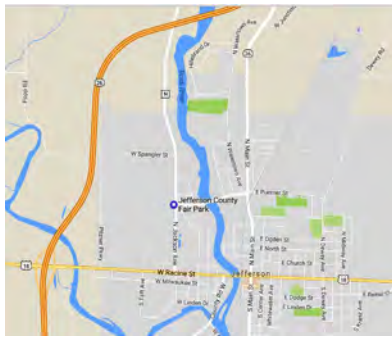

PLEASE NOTE

The Clubs have instituted the following rules in the hopes of making things easier for everyone.

- Parking fees \$5.00 per day per car/van.
- Admission is Free to Spectators.
- Day Electric hook up \$35.00 per day.
- UNLOADING INFORMATION - please follow posted directions to facilitate an orderly flow in and out of unloading area:
NO PARKING, UNLOADING OR LOADING IN THE FIRE LANES BETWEEN BUILDINGS. VIOLATORS WILL BE FINED AND VEHICLES TOWED.

ON THURSDAY: -NO ADMITTANCE OF VEHICLES OR PEOPLE UNTIL 2:00 P.M. REGARDING SET-UP OF EQUIPMENT. "The Clubs reserve the right to have exhibitors move or rearrange equipment as required to conserve space when requested by the show committee".

- **Non-reserved indoor grooming space is limited to the Cleary building. Admittance to this building will be at 2:00 PM. There will be NO saving of space with cones, tape, electrical cords, etc. All equipment must be present and set up. The warm-up arena is also available for grooming.**

- NO MATS allowed anywhere in the building.

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS...

BEST PUPPY-Best Puppy will be selected from the Puppy Classes following the judging of Best of Breed and Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a puppy class are eligible to compete for Best Puppy.
BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR-Best Bred by Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred by Exhibitor Dog and Bitch Classes following the judging of Best of Breed and Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Bred By Exhibitor Class are eligible to compete for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor.
BEST VETERAN-Best Veteran will be selected from the regular Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes following the judging of Best of Breed and Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated regular Veteran classes are eligible to compete for Best Veteran.

NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Because the judge's decision in multiple-entry classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the unit will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won this class.

Stud Dog Class-For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Stud Dog to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Neutered Stud Dogs are eligible for entry in this class.

Brood Bitch Class-Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. Spayed Brood Bitches are eligible for entry in this class.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.

The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).
