The Building will be locked at 10:00 P.M. on Friday, April 5 and Saturday, April 6, 2019. The Building will reopen at 6:30 A.M. Each Day. All dogs and equipment must be removed from the show site following Best in Show on Sunday, April 7, 2019.

ENTRY FEES-EACH DAY & LIMITS

NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE EVENT, ONLY THE FIRST EVENT WILL BE PROCESSED.

ENTRY FEE is \$30.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$20.00 for each event. Sweepstakes is \$20.00 for each event (where offered). JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP is \$16.00 if entered for 'Junior Showmanship Only' for each event or as an Additional Entry for each event. Four-To-Six Month Beginner Puppy is \$20.00. FSS Open Show is \$20.00. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$2.00 AKC Recording fee for Four-To-Six Month Beginner Puppy & FSS Open Show. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

PARKING

The Kennel Club of Yorkville, Illinois. 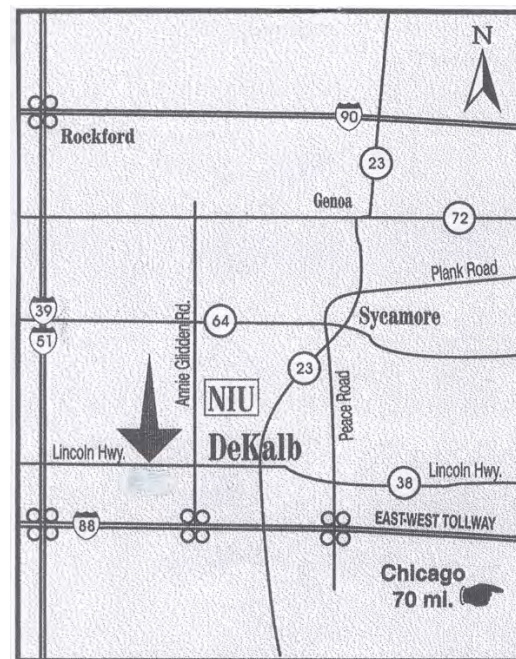

- Site will be available Friday, April 5, 2019. The Building will be open to Vendors ONLY at 2:00 P.M. Exhibitors may enter the building at 4:00 P.M. (NO EXCEPTIONS).The Building will be locked at 10:00 P.M. on Friday, April 5 and Saturday, April 6, 2019. The Building will reopen at 6:30 A.M. each day. All dogs and equipment must be removed from the show site following Best in Show on Sunday, April 7, 2019.
- **DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT, BUT MUST BE CRATED. A local contact or cell phone number must be left with dogs crated overnight.**
- **BUILDING IS HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE TO MAIN FLOOR & GROOMING AREA.**
- The management/Superintendent/Club or its members will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on site or for possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody and control of its owner, agent or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds. Show Superintendent and the employees of the Club and/or the Superintendent, will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through loss, theft, injury and/or death of dogs entered at these events, whether said loss, theft, injury and/or death is or are caused by the negligence or carelessness of the said Kennel Club, their members, directors, officers, agents, Superintendent or by negligence of any person or by any other cause.
- All grooming is indoors. Limited electric is available in several areas. Please share outlets.
- **Grooming in designated areas only.** Grooming areas will be monitored and supervised. The club reserves the right to restrict or consolidate grooming space.
- Crates and equipment must be stacked.
- No rugs or mats on the floor.
- Private exercise pens are **NOT** allowed in building. **No ex-pens used as crates.** This includes puppy/cocker/drop pens. Ample OUTSIDE exercise area is available and **MUST** be kept clean. Those individuals not picking up after their dogs will be subject to discipline.
- No saving of grooming or parking spaces. Tape, cords, rope and cones will be removed and become the property of the Kennel Club.
- In accordance with building regulations: **NO** materials may be taped, stapled, nailed, tacked etc. to the floors, walls, ceiling or posts.
- Limited crate space may be available on level of the main show rings. There is no electric available on the show floor and no dryers are allowed.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their grooming area clean. Please bring a broom and keep the grooming area free of debris.
- Aisles must be kept clear.
- Exhibitors are reminded to honor "NO DOG" areas. Dogs are not allowed in the Convocation Center lobby, on the passenger elevator or on tiled floor areas. Dogs are allowed in the freight elevator.
- This is a handicapped accessible facility with elevator access. No dogs are permitted on this elevator.
- The **FREIGHT ELEVATOR** is available during hours posted by the University. Staircases are available all day.
- **Unentered dogs are not allowed on the show grounds.**Dogs in attendance solely for the health clinics should stay in the clinic area and leave the building following their scheduled appointment.
- All dogs must be on a leash except while in obedience competition or when on the table, crated, or in an exercise pen. Dogs left on the table or in an ex-pen **MUST** be properly supervised.

FSS OPEN SHOW for All Miscellaneous & FSS Breeds BOTH DAYS

All dogs four (4) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs must be at least 4 months of age on the date of the event.

The following breed classes will be offered at all FSS Open Shows: (All Classes Divided by sex)

- 4-6 Month Puppy Class
- 6-9 Month Puppy Class
- 9-12 Month Puppy Class
- Bred-By-Exhibitor Class
- Open Class

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

- Dogs less than 4 months of age are ineligible to be on the grounds of licensed or member shows during AKC events.
- Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol (including rabies vaccination) in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open Shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.
- Any person acting in the capacity of Show Secretary at an FSS Open Show, or any member of his immediate household or immediate family (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows), shall not exhibit, act as agent or handler at the event, and dogs owned wholly or in part by the show secretary or by any member of their immediate household or immediate family shall be ineligible to be entered at that show.
- No judge or any person residing in the same household with a judge shall exhibit or act as agent or handler at an FSS Open Show at which they are officiating as judge and dogs owned wholly or in part by such judge or any member of their household shall be ineligible to be entered at the show. Subject to the foregoing, members of a judge's immediate family who no longer reside in the same household may enter or handle a dog at a show if the judge is not officiating over any competition, including a group class or Best in Show, for which the dog is entered or may become eligible.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION BOTH DAYS

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Classes will be offered for Breeds & Varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class Breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous Class competition will be equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS Competition will be the equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS Number of FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS Breed Entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.

These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed. Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
