ENTRY FEE is \$28.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event, except in Puppy Classes which are \$22.00. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$22.00. All Sweepstakes entries are \$21.00 (where offered). JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP is \$22.00 for each event if entered for 'Junior Showmanship Only' or if an Additional Entry for each event. RALLY entries are \$28.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event & \$22.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally and a \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog.  Exit Kenosha County Fairgrounds, turn Left onto Co. Hwy W, continue North to Hwy 50, turn Right, Continue onto the City of Kenosha until you reach 39th Avenue, (5 way intersection), turn Left and continue onto destination which will be on your Right.
WVRC Emergency & Specialty Pet Care, 4333 Old Green Bay Rd., Racine, WI 53403 • 262-553-9223.
 Exit Kenosha Co. Fairgrounds. Turn right (South) onto Co Hwy. W, go approx. 3 blocks, turn left (East) onto Co. Hwy. C., go approx. 11 miles. Turn right (East) onto Hwy. 50, go approx. .7 mile, turn left (North) onto Hwy. 31, go approx. 8.5 miles. Turn right (East) onto Braun Rd., go 1 block to stop sign. Turn right (South) onto Old Green Bay Rd., go 1 block. Greenbay Road Animal Emergency Clinic will be directly off the road on the left.

• NOTE •

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

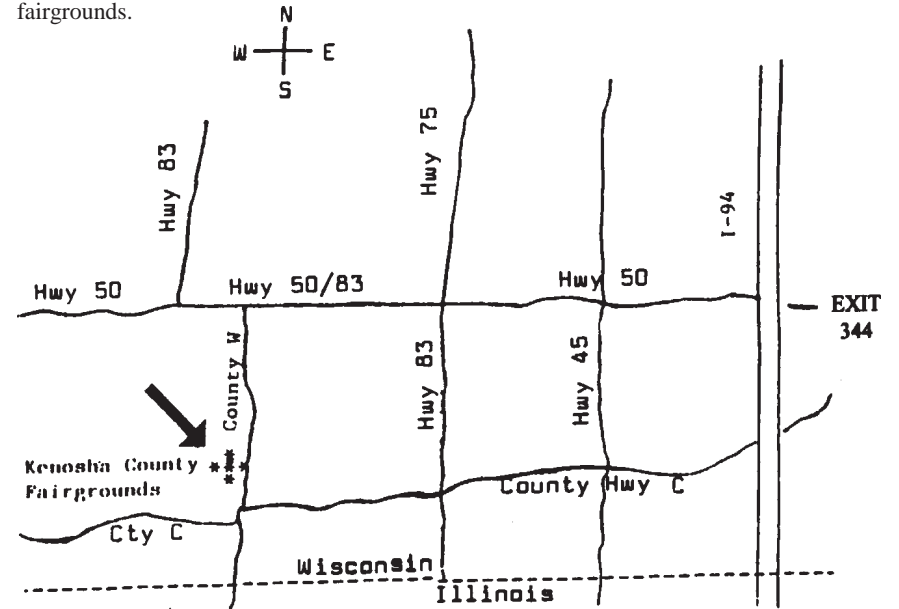

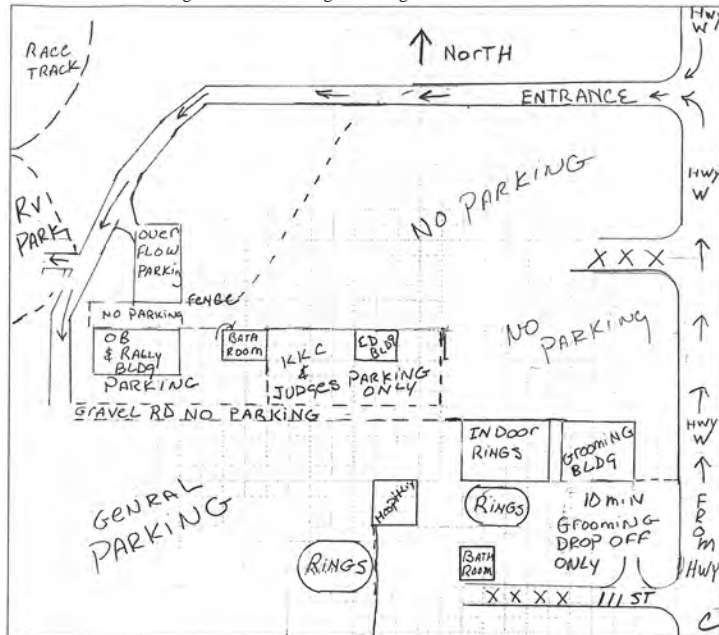

AKC National Owner-Handled Series....

Saturday, September 9, 2017 & Sunday, September 10, 2017

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
 - Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
 - Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.
 - If the Best of Breed/Variety winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, it will also be awarded Owner Handled Best of Breed. In this case, the dog will be eligible to compete in group competition for the regular show and group competition for the AKC National Owner Handled Series.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
 - If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, Owner Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded and the Breed/Variety will not be represented in group competition for the AKC National Owner Handled Series.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. OPEN SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS-This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

*By Board approved policy Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei & Chow Chows must be judged on the ramp in all conformation competition associated with AKC conformation dog shows or at which AKC conformation titles may be earned.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).
