



Note: "Neutered dogs & Spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes only at Independent Specialties and/ or those All-Breed Shows which do not offer any Competition beyond Best of Breed." AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11. Section 8.

WORKING DOG CLASS WORKING BITCH CLASS

Classes for dogs/bitches holding NCA Working Title(s) (Draft Dog, DD; Water Dog, WD; Water Rescue Dog, WRD; Team Draft Dog, TDD) and MAY NOT be Spayed or Neutered. Winners may compete for Best of Breed competition if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

AWARDS OF MERIT

Awards of Merit may be given at the Judge's discretion, irrespective of the sex of the dogs entered. The Award of Merit shall be offered based on the number of dogs competing for Best of Breed. The number of awards are determined by the size of the entry of the Best of Breed Class: 7-10 entries-up to 1 Award of Merit, 11-16 entries-up to 2 Awards of Merit, 17-23 entries-up to 3 Awards of Merit, 24-30 entries-up to 4 Awards of Merit, 31-36 entries-up to 5 Awards of Merit, 37 or more entries-up to 6 Awards of Merit. Winners will receive a Rosette.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES

*NOTE: Because the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes will be based on the Merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won this class.

STUD DOG CLASS-For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in any Regular Classes, or if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition, but MUST BE entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST BE entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog is considered as one entry & requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The Class will be judged on the Merits of the Get. BROOD BITCH CLASS-Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS-Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- · Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- · Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- · Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.





NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Event Secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. This policy extends to Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special

attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. The list of Table and Ramp breeds can be found on the AKC Website under Conformation Judges - Announcements. Emergencies In emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).
