All dogs entered in this event must have an AKC Conformation Championship. If the breed is eligible for AKC field titles, (except for Standard Poodles and Samoyeds), the dog must have the AKC title. These breeds will not have to submit proof of little with their entry.

If the breed does not have a format AKC program but the parent club has set minimum performance standards for the breed, a working certificate from the parent club will be acceptable. However these dogs must submit proof of title with their entries in the form of a photocopy of the title certificate from the parent club. These titles will be listed specifically for those breeds where the parent club has replied to the show committee's query. If the parent club has not informed the show committee of specific degrees and the requirements for those degrees, working certificates from those parent clubs may be subject to review by the show secretary and members of the show committee to determine eligibility.

Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible for this event provided they meet the eligibility requirements for their breed.

****Note...** if the breed does not have a set of minimum performance standard available for a working certificate, the dog must have a minimum of an AKC Companion Dog (CD) Title.

SPORTING GROUP

All sporting dogs except American Water Spaniels must have one of the following titles combinations: DC (Dual Champion) or a Champion with an Amateur Field Championship (AFC), MH (Master Hunter), SH (Senior Hunter) or JH (Junior Hunter).

American Water Spaniels must be AKC Conformation champions and have a SD, WD, WDX, or WDS from the American Water Spaniel Club. (These field titles will require proof of titles).

HOUND GROUP

The following breeds must have a DC or be champions with an MC (Master Courser), SC (Senior Courser) or a JC (Junior Courser): Afghans, Basenjis, Borzois, Greyhounds, Borzois, Greyhounds, Ibizans, Irish Wolfhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Saluki, Scottish Deerhounds and Whippets.

Bassets and Beagles must have a DC.

Dachshunds must have a DC or be champions with an ME (Master Earthdog), SE (Senior Earthdog) or JE (Junior Earthdog).

Bloodhounds must be champions with a TD (Tracking Dog) or TDX (Tracking Dog Excellent).

All other sent hounds must be champions with a working certificate from their respective parent clubs. These certificates are subject to review to determine eligibility. **

WORKING GROUP

All Rottweilers must be champions with one of the AKC herding titles.

Samoyeds must be champions and may have either an AKC herding titles or a WS, WSX, or WSXM from the Samoyed Club of America.

Newfoundland's must be champions and have one of the following titles from the parent club: WD (Water Dog), WRD (Water Rescue Dog), DD (Draft Dog), TDD (Team Draft Dog.)

Alaskan Malamutes must be champions with a WTD (Working Team Dog), WLD (Working Lead Dog), WPD (Working Pack Dog), WWP (Working Weight Pull Dog), WTDX, WLDX, WPDX or WWPDX certificate from the parent club.

Doberman Pinschers must be champions and have WAT (Working Aptitude Test) certificate from the parent club.

All other working breeds must have working certificate from the parent club. These certificates are subject to review to determine eligibility. **

TERRIER GROUP

The following breeds must have a conformation championship with an ME (Master Earth dog), SE (Senior Earth dog) or a JE (Junior Earth dog): Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Dandies Dumont, Fox (smooth and wire), Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull Terrier, Miniature Schnauzers, Norfolk, Norwich, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Welsh and West Highland White.

Airedales must have a conformation championship and one of the following titles: JHF (junior hunter flusher, JHR (Junior hunter retriever), Hour (Junior Hunter Fur), SHF, SHR, Shafer, MHF, MHR, MHFur. Airedales with have a to submit proof of title with their entries.

All other Terrier breeds must be champions, and when available, have a working certificate from the parent club. These certificates are subject to review to determine eligibility. **

TOY GROUP

toy breeds must be champions, and when available, have working certificate from the parent club. These certificates are subject to review to determine eligibility. **

NON-SPORTING GROUP

All non-sporting breeds except Standard Poodles must be champions with a working certificate from the parent club. These certificates are subject to review to determine eligibility. **

HERDING GROUP

All dogs in the herding group must be champions with one of the following titles: HT (Herding Tested), PT (Pre-trial Tested), HS (Herding Started), HI (Herding Intermediate), HX (Herding Excellent) Hoch (Herding Champion).

HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
