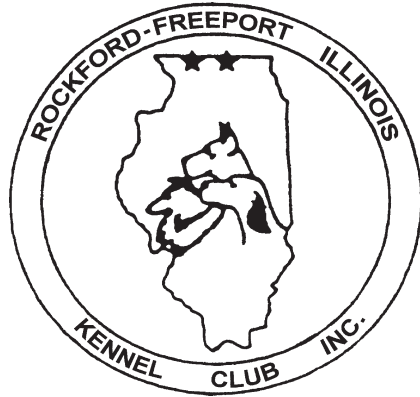

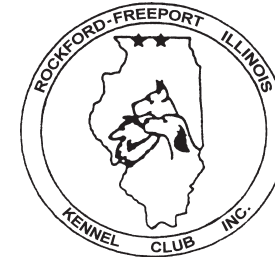

ENTRY FEE is \$29.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event, except for Puppy Classes which are \$25.00 for each event. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$24.00 for each event. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP is \$23.00 if entered for 'Junior Showmanship Only' for each event or FREE if entered as an Additional Entry. Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes Entry Fee is \$15.00 for each event (*where offered*). 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy fee is \$10.00 for the first entry of each dog. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$2.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. (There are no recording fees or event service fees for sweepstakes, Junior showmanship, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2019 & SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2019

The purpose of the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.
- Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, it will also be awarded Owner-Handled Best of Breed. In this case, the dog will be eligible to compete in group competition for the regular show and group competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.
- If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition and the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner-Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner-Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, Owner-Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded and the breed/variety will not be represented in group competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.

WILL OFFER A "BEST PUPPY" COMPETITION

Rockford-Freepport Illinois Kennel Club, Inc., as part of its All-Breed show, will hold a Best Puppy Competition. Competition will be for Best Puppy in Breed/Variety, Best Puppy in Group (with placements one through four) and Best Puppy in Show.

Rules: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the class winner of the 6 months & under 9 months, and from the 9 months & under 12 months classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the puppy classes is awarded Best of Winner or Best of Breed/Variety. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **MAY NOT** compete. All Best Puppies in Breed/Variety will compete in their respective Best Puppy Group. All Best in Group Puppies will compete for Best Puppy in Show.

There will be **no additional** entry fee for this competition. Dogs must be entered in the regular 6 months & under 9 months Puppy Class or 9 months & under 12 months Puppy Class to be eligible for the Best Puppy Competition.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2019

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. Classes will be offered for Breeds & Varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class Breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous Class competition will be equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS Competition will be the equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS Number of FSS Registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS Breed Entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- **Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class.** Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Entries Close at the Superintendent's Office, WEDNESDAY NOON (EDT), SEPTEMBER 11, 2019. (no day of show entries accepted.)

This will be done after Best of Breed & Award of Merit judging. Example: A Veteran Class winner is awarded Best of Breed then Best Veteran award is automatic. Only dogs **not defeated** in regular Veteran classes are eligible to compete for Best Veteran.
