**SOMETHING NEW ..... PRACTICE RING**

Want to give that puppy some ring practice, get him or her used to the surroundings he will be showing in on Saturday? Good for older dogs too! Allows them to stretch their legs after traveling in a crate.

**On Friday night, April 27** (the night before the SAMI specialty) we will have a **Practice ring**. You can sign up on Friday night with Jeanne Nonhof and ring time will commence once the ring is set up. The cost is \$5.00 for 5 minutes per dog. In your 5 minutes, you can practice whatever you want, gaiting, stacking, baiting, etc. You can invite another person in to direct the training and go over the dog. You are renting ring time. If you want a second round, that will be allowed after all of the other people who want to participate have had their chance.**ENTRY FEES****NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT! **EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE**

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of current rabies vaccination must be in the possession of exhibitors or handlers for all dogs at these trials.

**• NOTE •**

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

**FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION  
GREATER MILWAUKEE SAMOYED FANCIERS, INC.  
SUNDAY, APRIL 29, 2018 - Event # 2018115902**

**Judge: Mr. Garry K. Newton**

The Four-To-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition shall be for Samoyeds that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.

- A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

*The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.*

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
  - Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show.
  - Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
  - Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner Handled Series competition.
  - Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.
  - If the Best of Breed winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, it will also be awarded Owner Handled Best of Breed.
  - If the regular show Best of Breed winner is not eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner Handled Best of Breed.
  - If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
  - If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
  - If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner Handled Best of Breed.
  - If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, Owner Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded.

**AWARD OF MERIT**

At the discretion of the judge, an Award of Merit may be given to 10% (always rounded downward) of all those competing for Best of Breed. The 10% figure shall be based on the total Best of Breed entry at the time of closing. i.e. disregarding absentees or transfers from the classes, plus two for Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, plus an additional number for each winner of the following classes: Veteran Dog, 8-10 yrs.; Veteran Dog 10-12 yrs. & Veteran Dog 12 yrs & over; Veteran Bitch, 8-10 yrs. and Veteran Bitch 10-12 yrs. & Veteran Bitch 12 yrs. & over, Working Dog and Working Bitch. All of those in Best of Breed Competition shall be eligible to receive an Award of Merit, except the Best of Breed winner, Select Dog Winner, Select Bitch Winner and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed winner.

**NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

*(Team Class Only offered for Sunday)*

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**Stud Dog Class**-For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed/Variety Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Stud Dog to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Neutered Stud Dogs are eligible for entry in this class.

**Brood Bitch Class**-Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. Spayed Brood Bitches are eligible for entry in this class.

**Brace Class**-For two dogs owned and/or co-owned by the exhibitor. Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Brace will require a fee see Page 2 as a unit, provided the dogs are entered in another class. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each such dog on an individual regular entry form and a separate fee must be paid for each such dog entered. Dogs comprising the Brace must be named at time of entry. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, they MUST be indicated as "Brace #1, Brace #2, etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.

**Team Class**-Effective January 1, 2005. A team is defined as four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in team competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Team MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be a part of a Team is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for "Best of Breed Competition," it must be entered for "Team Only". In making entries for "Team Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as a part of a Team MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes-"Team Class." If more than one Team is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Team must be so designated-"Team No. 1," "Team No. 2," etc. PLEASE SUBMIT TEAM ENTRIES TOGETHER.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS**-For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

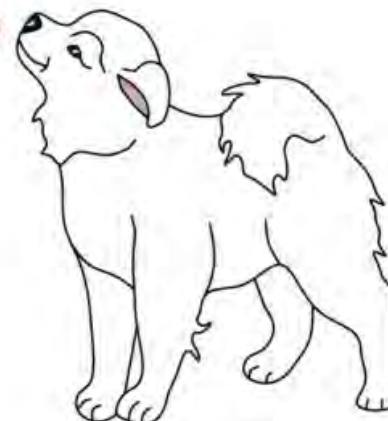
