The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR-The regular breed judge after will judge these classes. Best Bred-by-Exhibitor will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Classes after Best of Breed is completed. If the Best of Winners or Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class then the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor is automatic.

BEST VETERAN-The regular breed judge will judge after Best Bred by Exhibitor. Best veteran will be between the winner of the best dog veteran and the best bitch veteran. If the Best of Breed is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from the Veteran class then the Best Veteran is automatic.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES

*NOTE: Because the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Entries will be based on the Merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won this class.

STUD DOG CLASS-Stud Dogs & two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. It is not necessary for the Stud Dog to be entered in another class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS-Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS-Two dogs, same breed, similar in appearance, performing in unison, and have at least one common owner. They can have a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". Full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Classes".

SLED DOG CLASS

A list of the races in which the dog completed, or a copy of the five year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Secretary when entry is made. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged.

1. Entry must be an American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club registered Siberian Husky (eligible under Chapter 15, Sec 1 of the AKC Rules regarding Registration & Dog Shows)
2. There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the discretion of the Show Chair additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degree Program.
3. If entered in a class for which full entry was paid, no additional fee will be required to also exhibit in the sled dog class. If not, the entry fee to exhibit solely in Sled Dog will be a regular entry fee.
4. To qualify for entry in Sled Dog Class, the dog must have completed one of the following requirements:
 - a. During the previous racing season, the applicant must complete ten (10) heats with a minimum of four (4) miles per heat, or the total miles per season not being less than 48 miles. All races must be on snow with sleds and under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A race season is from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.
 - b. Entries who compete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the chair of the Working Committee if the 5 years of proof of competition records are sent in.
 - c. Entries who have been awarded a SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX, or SDO, and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
5. Spayed or neutered dogs are not exhibited in the Sled Dog Class as required by the American Kennel Club.

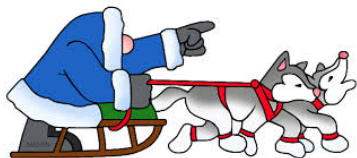

*By Board approved policy Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei & Chow Chows must be judged on the ramp in all conformation competition associated with AKC conformation dog shows or at which AKC conformation titles may be earned.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Event Secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. This policy extends to Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Puppy and BIS competitions. The list of Table and Ramp breeds can be found on the AKC Website under Conformation Judges - Announcements. Emergencies in emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).
