ENTRY FEES -EACH DAY & LIMITS

When a dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class is considered the first entry. If a dog is entered in any combination of Conformation, Obedience or Rally with separate event numbers, the first entry fee is required for each event for each day.

NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE EVENT, ONLY THE FIRST EVENT WILL BE PROCESSED.

ENTRY FEE is \$29.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$25.00 for each event. **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP** is \$10.00 for each event if entered for 'Junior Showmanship Only' or if an Additional Entry for each event. All Sweepstakes Classes (where offered) are \$15.00 for each event. Rally is \$29.00 for the first entry for each event, each additional entry of the same dog in Rally is \$25.00 for each event. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally and a \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

• NOTE •

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

EXPO RULES AND RV GUIDELINES

THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to a show committee hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club.

- Day RV Parking **ONLY** in Gate #1. **No overnight parking will be allowed.** Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV parking area through Gate #3 and will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Noncompliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.
- Entrance to RV Camping is Gate #3.
- Access to Gate #3 – Upon arrival to Gate #3, participants will need to provide a copy of their registration confirmation. Once registration has been verified, a parking pass will be provided to be displayed in the window of the RV. Access to Gate #3 is limited to:
 - o Recreational vehicles with proper parking pass displayed in the window.
 - o Handler/Exhibitor vehicles with proper parking forms displayed in the window. One vehicle per site. Any handler/exhibitors without proper parking confirmations must enter through Gate #1 and use the designated "Handler Drop Off area."
 - o Club members and workers with appropriate pass (Friday – Sunday).
- After 9 p.m., RVs are welcome to enter Gate #3 to be staged in Arena West Parking Lot until the next morning. No electrical hookups available.
- Wednesday (7/26) RV arrivals are welcome from Noon – 9 p.m.
- A noise curfew is in effect from 10 p.m. until sunrise. This applies to all types of loud noises, including, but not limited to, music and stereos. Please be considerate of your neighbors so everyone can have a pleasant time.
- Grills are allowed by individual RV sites only, not on the show grounds. Hot coals should not be dumped into Expo trash containers or dumpsters. Absolutely NO campfires of any kind will be allowed.
- No tent camping will be allowed.
- All dogs must be kept on a 6 ft. or less leash, unless in designated dog show rings.
- All campers are responsible for cleaning up and properly disposing of all trash, recyclable items and dog droppings. Please place items in proper receptacles found throughout the Expo Grounds. Failure to follow this rule may result in additional charges or not being allowed to camp on-site for future shows.
- Cancellations of RV Camping and Handler Parking: A full refund will be given if cancelled on or before July 11, 2017. If cancelled July 12, 2017 or later, the reservation fee will be forfeited.

AKC Owner-Handled Series SATURDAY, JULY 29, 2017 & SUNDAY, JULY 30, 2017

The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler’s handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC’s records as of the date of the show.
 - Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
 - Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
 - Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge’s book, steward’s book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.
 - If the Best of Breed/Variety winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, it will also be awarded Owner Handled Best of Breed. In this case, the dog will be eligible to compete in group competition for the regular show and group competition for the AKC National Owner Handled Series.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
 - If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, Owner Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded and the Breed/Variety will not be represented in group competition for the AKC National Owner Handled Series.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, Winners of Multiple-dog Entry Classes are not eligible for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of winning one of these classes.

Stud Dog Class-For Stud Dogs and at least 2 but not more than 4 of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog does not have to be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.
