waiting to jump. Try-its cost \$10.00 FOR 6 minutes on the dock. If a try-it or competing

**ENTRY FEES -EACH DAY & LIMITS**

When a dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class is considered the first entry. If a dog is entered in any combination of Conformation, Obedience or Rally with separate event numbers, the first entry fee is required for each event for each day.

**NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE EVENT, ONLY THE FIRST EVENT WILL BE PROCESSED.**

**ENTRY FEE** is \$29.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event, except for Puppy classes, which is \$25.00. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$22.00 for each event. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP is \$10.00 for each event if entered for 'Junior Showmanship Only' or if an Additional Entry for each event. All Sweepstakes Classes (where offered) are \$15.00 for each event. Rally is \$29.00 for the first entry for each event, first additional entry of the same dog in Rally is \$22.00 for each event, second additional entry in Rally is \$19.00. TOP JUNIOR HANDLER COMPETITION is \$10.00. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally and a \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. *"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."*

**Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs**

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>.

**• NOTE •**

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog.

Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.

THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to a show committee hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club.

- The only vehicles allowed within the show area (within 50' of all rings), are First Aid, Security, Expo Staff, and Waukesha Kennel Club dog show staff. All private golf carts, utility vehicles, and ATV's must be used around the outer perimeter of the event.
- Day RV Parking ONLY in Gate #1. No overnight parking will be allowed. Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV parking area through Gate #3 and will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Noncompliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.
- Entrance to RV Camping is Gate #3.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
